



Odds on a winner for charity

TABCORP has thrown its support behind *The Daily Telegraph* Punters Club's Brightexpectations and could donate as much as \$250,000 to charity if the grey colt wins the AAMI Golden Slipper at Rosehill Gardens.

And the NSW TAB will offer punters a chance to back Brightexpectations at the inflated odds of \$7 to win the \$3.5 million race.

Brightexpectations is currently a \$5.50 chance with TAB fixed odds but a one-off special offer, available tomorrow only, gives punters odds of \$7. Brightexpectations' odds of \$7 to win the Golden Slipper will only be available until the TAB reaches a maximum exposure of \$125,000.

Tabcorp will also match its exposure (as a result of inflating his price), with a \$125,000 donation to Red Kite — a charity providing support for families with children suffering from cancer.

Tabcorp's Ian Mackay said the special offer was available only to new and existing TAB account holders.
