Organise a movie night in the school hall, sell tickets and popcorn, and donate the proceeds!

Hold a cake or sweet stall during recess – use red icing on your baking for a special Redkite touch!

Practice your favourite musical instrument or your best dance moves and put on a music concert. Ask your friends and family to sponsor you... maybe they could even join you on stage!

Host a school trivia night to determine who really is the smartest student, teacher or parent. You can even raffle off some prizes on the night to raise additional funds!

Hold a school challenge event, like a walk-a-thon or a spelling bee - ask your friends and family to sponsor you per km (or word)!

Nominate Redkite as the charity beneficiary for your school's annual party or concert and donate entry fees to support children and young people with cancer

Hold a kite-making competition - make red kites and have a kite flying competition with a small entry fee to be donated



Raising over \$500 can go towards music therapy sessions to help children manage their pain and cope with the stress of cancer and its treatment.



Raising over \$1000 could fund social worker's counselling sessions, in person or by phone, for distressed parents with nowhere to turn.
